□Writer dispatched, from 40th Street and North Tamiami Trail, to a report of a shooting which occurred at 4015 Bradenton Road. I parked my vehicle at the southwest corner of 40th Street and Bradenton Road upon arrival and walked to the address in question. I observed a white male, later identified as Sean Boice, standing in the front doorway with a telephone in his hand.

□When Mr. Boice saw me he began to wave toward me and stated, they're shot they're shot, he then turned around and ran back into the residence. I followed and ask him who did the shooting? Boice stated that, she shot our baby, she shot our baby".

□I followed Boice through the living room toward the northeast bedroom where I observed a white female, later identified as Sara Harnish, lying face down in the doorway; there was a large pool of blood surrounding her head. Mr. Boice stepped over Harnish before I could stop him and jumped onto the bed next to a white female infant, later identified as Josephine Boice, he yelled, "She is still breathing". Josephine appeared to be shot in the right temple with severe blood loss but was still breathing.

□I notified SSO communications of Josephine's condition and picked her up from the bed and carried her out to the Sarasota Fire Department ambulance that was just then arriving. I handed Josephine to a paramedic inside the ambulance.

□Officers Panichello and McCroskey had arrived on scene and I instructed Officer Panichello to stay with Josephine. I ask McCroskey to stand by with Sean Boice as I went back inside to check on Sara. I checked for a pulse on Sara's neck, finding none I "cleared" the residence and found no one else inside.

□I did observe that Sara appeared to still be holding in her right hand, between her legs, a small black semi auto pistol; I did not touch/disturb this item.

□I notified Sgt. J. Deniro of the situation and the security of the scene; he in turn coordinated efforts to secure the scene with arriving officers.

□While inside the residence I did not observe anything other than previously mentioned, items that appeared out of place or otherwise suspicious in nature. I did not search the residence other than to ascertain if any other subjects/victims were inside. Mr. Boice remained outside the residence after following me out with Josephine, with Officer McCroskey and later with Officer Pucci. Officer Pucci later transported Mr. Boice to the Sarasota Police Department.
